COOPÉRATIVE D'HABITATION BEAUPARLANT INC.

APPEAL COMMITTEE POLICY and PROCEDURES

COOPÉRATIVE D'HABITATION BEAUPARLANT, in compliance with the HSA requirements has established the following *Appeal Committee Policy and Procedures:*

- 1. There will be 3 (three) members on the appeal committee.
- 2. The committee will consist of 2 staff personnel from the Co-op's Management Company and 1 board member.
- 3. The committee will be responsible to deal with appeals/reviews of the following decisions: *a. RGI eligibility*
 - b. RGI payable
 - c. Occupancy Standards (on an ongoing annual basis)
- 4. All members of the Appeal Committee would serve as volunteers and only be compensated for travel expenses.
- 5. An Appeal Committee serves an important role by providing third-party review to ensure a fair, impartial and transparent process for all appeals.

The following **STANDARDS** will apply:

- 1. Committee members cannot have participated in the original decision being reviewed.
- 2. Committee members cannot have discussed the original decision with the decision-maker prior to the review.
- 3. An individual may only participate in a review as a member of the committee if the individual is knowledgeable about the provisions of the *HSA* and the regulations that are relevant to the decision being reviewed.
- 4. All committee members will review the applicable legislation prior to the meeting to ensure all members are aware of the **HSA** legislative requirements.
- 5. Request additional training as needed from NRH.

The following **PROCEDURAL RULES** will apply:

- If an appeal is being requested on a decision made by the original decision-maker, it
 must be in writing addressed to *Board of Directors of the Coopérative d'habitation*Beauparlant Appeals Committee and must be made within 10 days of the original
 date of the decision.
- 2. Upon receipt of the appeal, the *Committee* will call a meeting within *30 days* to hear the appeal and make its decision. The *Committee decision* shall be final.
- 3. The member will be permitted to attend the review and bring an advocate of their choice, if they wish.
- 4. A written notice of the Appeal Decision must be given within 5 days.
